Drawing is a wonderful activity and essentially all you need are a few pencils and some paper, check out the suggested materials on page 2

You may find brilliant artist pencils in Hobbycraft or the Range, a set in a tin is great but single pencils are just as good, they last for years!

You don't need coloured pencils but if you think you will want them then again there is a huge range, a great thing to add later on

PENCILS - STARTING OUT

- ✿ Either a tin with H pencils or mix of H and B pencils
- ✿ Singles of H, HB and B pencils say one of each
- ✿ coloured pencils - if you like colour!
- ✿ B pencils are soft and range from HB to 9B great for dark shading
- ✿ H pencils are hard and range from HB to 9H great for lighter shading
- ✿ F is for Fine!

You can also get 'graphite' pencils - can get a little messy but give a lot of shading, as well as charcoal pencils. Other local suppliers are WH Smiths, Hobbycraft, The Range

ERASERS

- ✿ Pen eraser! A super invention
- ✿ Putty Rubber - great for lifting off pencil and not erasing the line completely
- ✿ Hard rubbers - just like in school quite chunky!

PAPER

- ✿ You could work in a cartridge sketchbook - A4 or smaller
- ✿ Or you could get a drawing pad - A4 or smaller ideal for class as you can take the pages out to work on the board with
- ✿ Single pages of cartridge paper - A4 or smaller

OTHER EQUIPMENT

- ✿ Ruler to draw a frame for your drawing
- ✿ flat board/tray to attach your paper to
- ✿ masking tape - low tack if you can get it
- ✿ pencils - H and HB or your selection
- ✿ Eraser and Sharpener

You may have equipment at home do bring it along. Sometimes we work in colour, or pen, Jane will supply anything needed as per course if you require it
